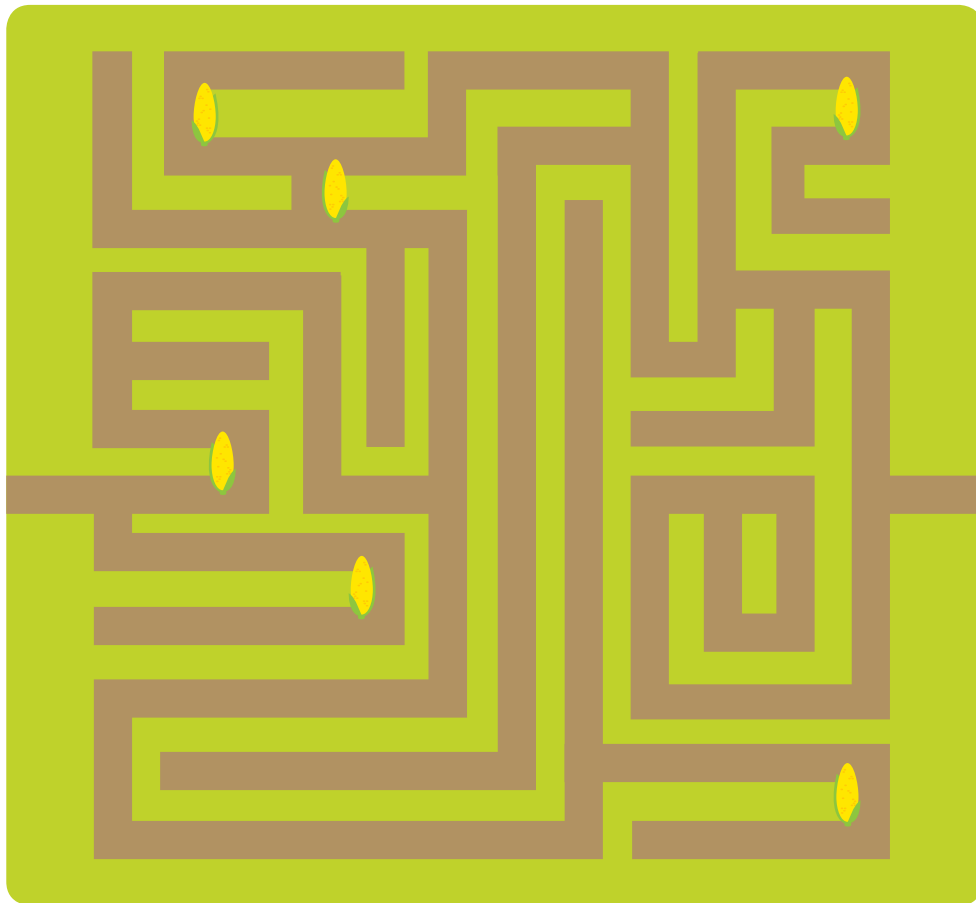


A-MAIZE-ING MAZE
